WAIVER OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND DISCLOSURES

Both parties have been advised that, pursuant to Rule 8.05 of the Uniform Chancery Court Rules, each party in every domestic case involving economic issues and/or property division shall provide the opposite party or counsel certain disclosures as specifically spelled out in the rule unless excused by Order of the Court. Rule 8.05 includes requirements of the following disclosures:

1. A detailed written statement of actual income, expenses, assets and liabilities, such statement to be on the form attached to the Rule;
2. Copies of preceding year's Federal and State Tax Returns, in full form as filed, or copies of W-2s if the return has not yet been filed; and
3. A general statement of the providing party describing employment history and earnings from the inception fo the marriage or the date of divorce, whichever is applicable.

Both parties are advised of their right to receive the financial statement and disclosures set forth in Rule 8.05 of the Uniform Chancery Court Rules. Both parties are aware of the obvious beneficial effect of this Rule. The parties have made themselves fully aware of Rule 8.05 and its advantages, and hereby waive the right and/or necessity to receive the information set forth in Rule 8.05 of the Uniform Chancery Court Rules, and further acknowledge that both of them are familiar with the work history of the other during the period of their marriage and are generally familiar with their individual and joint assets, liabilities, income and expenses.
