CONSENT TO DIVORCE-IRRECONCILABLE DIFFERENCES

COMES NOW the Defendant, _____, and having previously entered an appearance in the cause of action, files this her Consent to Divorce-Irreconcilable Differences, and in support thereof would show unto this Honorable Court she does join in the Complaint for Divorce-Irreconcilable Differences filed by her husband and the Plaintiff, _____, on _____, and confesses same as true and correct and does hereby affirm the parties are separated, and irreconcilable differences exist between the parties and they can no longer live together as husband and wife. WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Defendant respectfully prays this, her Consent to Divorce-Irreconcilable Differences, be received and filed, and upon a final consideration of this matter, the Court will enter its Judgment, granting the following relief:

- (A) A final and absolute divorce and dissolution of the marriage of the parties on the ground of irreconcilable differences;
- (B) The Court find the Property Settlement Agreement, when agreed and executed between the parties, adequately and sufficiently provides for the settlement of all property rights and any and all other rights and obligations existing between the

parties as a result of their marriage contract and relationship, and the Court will approve same, ordering said parties duly perform each act and thing agreed to therein, and said Agreement be made a part of this Court's Final Judgment; and,

(C) Upon the expiration of sixty (60) days from the date of filing of the Complaint, it be taken as confessed and a Final Judgment be entered herein without proof or testimony in term time or in vacation.
